Hanging Instructions









Keys to a Successful Installation

- Installation by an experienced professional paper hanger is strongly recommended.
- Inspect the wallcoverings after hanging three strips and throughout the installation to see if it meets your expectations. If you notice any problems during the installation, stop hanging and consult your supplier. Claims for labor will not be honored. The Wallcoverings will be considered acceptable once more than three strips of wallcovering have been hung.
- All rolls should be from the same run/batch number.
- Be sure you have enough of all decorative materials before beginning the installation.
- Careful wall preparation is vital to achieve the perfect finish.
- * Use a high-quality wall-liner such as Wallquest® Premium Wall Liner (WL100) before hanging (OPTIONAL)
- Use a high quality pre-mixed, clear adhesive such as ACM Adhesive, Roman® or Bartoline®
- Use a very sharp blade and change the blade frequently to ensure a clean cut.
- Allow wallcoverings to remain on the site for 3 days at normal environmental conditions before installing.

Wall Preparation

Walls must be clean, dry, and free from grease, dirt, mold or and any loose material. Apply a stain killing primer if necessary. Then apply a primer specifically designed for wallcoverings installation and wall protection. Allow primer to dry and seal the walls with wallpaper size. Again, allow the walls to dry completely before proceeding.

*Wall Liner Installation (OPTIONAL)

Install the wall-liner in a horizontal manner. This will help to eliminate any existing imperfections in the wall. It will also ease the removal of the wallcoverings in the future. When the walls are dry, they should be sealed using a wallpaper size.

PASTE THE SHEET INSTRUCTION

- 1. Cut and hang only one strip at a time. Cut each strip to the height of the wall plus 15 cm (6 in). BE SURE TO ACCOUNT FOR THE MATCH OF THE PATTERN BEFORE CUTTING THE STRIP.
- 2. Apply a heavy duty pre-mixed vinyl adhesive to the wallcovering(Dilution of adhesive is not recommended), carefully following the paste manufacturer's instructions. Please ensure sufficient paste is applied to the edges of the wallcovering.
- 3. Fold the strip slowly, glue on glue, by taking both ends to the middle of the strip (booking). Let it sit for 10 minutes.
- 4. Start hanging each strip from the top and use a soft brush to smooth it into place. Try to minimize the amount of paste on the face of the wallcoverings during hanging. Low tack painters tape can be used to protect the edge of previously hung adjoining strips from paste.
- 5. Carefully use your palms to butt the edge of each of the strips together.
- 6. Gently use a seam roller with a plain piece of paper to ensure that the edges are firmly adhered to the wall. If you apply too much force the roller may leave an indentation in the wallcoverings.
- 7. Use a sharp blade and a straight edge to line the top and the bottom of the strip.
- 8. IMPORTANT: If possible, wash adhesive completely from the surface of the wallcovering immediately after hanging each strip. Any adhesive left on the wallcovering can attack the surface printed inks and cause them to flake. The materials are also sensitive to prolonged contact with water. DO NOT ALLOW PASTE TO DRY ON THE SURFACE. DO NOT SCRUB!
- 9. Once installed, allow the wallcoverings to dry naturally without additional heat or forced drying. Be sure there is adequate ventilation in the room.
- 10. PROFESSIONAL TIP: A heat gun can be used to facilitate ease of installation around corners.

Cleaning

Stains and paste on the surface should be removed as quickly as possible to eliminate any possible reaction between the staining agent and the wallcovering. Ordinary dirt and smudges can be removed with a mild soap and warm water. Clean from the bottom of the wall upward to protect the baseboard and to prevent streaking. Rinse thoroughly with clean water from the top down using a sponge. Blot wallcovering dry with a soft, lint-free towel. For more difficult stains, use of a stronger detergent is recommended. Try an inconspicuous spot first before attempting the entire wall. Always rinse the wall well after applying a detergent. The use of steel wool or powdered abrasive cleaners is not recommended for cleaning. Do not use active solvent type cleaning preparations, such as nail polish remover, tar and bug removers or liquid cleaners with a high alcohol content exceeding 50%.
